Before the February 25 snowstorm, I stacked firewood, under the eave of my house, on my deck and placed some larger pieces near my fireplace and



He explained that if we decided to use the program that all our prescriptions would be filled at the same time each month through a synchronization program and that Downey's makes all the calls to doctors' offices for refills. All medications and supplements are pre-packaged and labeled in tear off dosage strips, and there is no charge for the E-Z Meds Program.


